BRAGS!



Maplecreek's Torquay Tory competed in the Green Bay agility trial on Aug. 26th and double Q'd with a pair of 2nd places. This was #10. Then on Sat. Sept. 2 and Mon. Sept. 4th he competed in the Timber Ridge Trial at Camp Bandy and he did 3 for 4 with a pair of 4th places and a 3rd place for double Q #11.

U-CD, U-AGII Maplecreek's Torquay Tory, CD, MX, MXJ, RN, FFX-AP, TDI competed at the Wisconsin Rapids KC agility trial on Fri. Sept. 22, and Sun. Sept. 24th and went 3 for 4 with his 12th double Q and a 1st place in JWW on Sunday. His other 2 Q's were 3rd places and he added 71 championship points to bring him up to over 850.

Cheryl Brimmer's Tune competed in the NAVHDA (N. American Versatile Hunting Dog Assoc.) Natural Ability Test on August 26th and did an awesome job for a 7 1/2 month pup. He earned 4/4 on Use of nose; Water Retrieve; Pointing: Tracking and Desire to Work. He earned 3/4 for Search (he spent too much time looking for where a flushed bird landed) and 3/4 for Cooperation (he didn't want to return the birds he caught -retrieve isn't a part of the test but he can't play keep away either). A "prize one" requires 99 points but he needed a minimum of 4 points on search. Tune had 105 points with a 3 on search for a "Prize Two". "I am so proud of the job he did." - Cheryl Brimmer

At the Great Lakes Belgian Tervuren Club herding trial on Sept, 9th, Scotty (Ch Aftershock Foxfyre Plaid Lad CD,HT,MX,AXJ) qualified in the Started (sheep) class to earn his HSAs (Herding Started A course sheep) title. On Sept. 10th, he moved up to the Intermediate (sheep) class, and not only qualified, but earned 2nd place in the class and the first leg of his HIAs (Herding Intermediate A course sheep) title. On both days Scotty was beautifully handled by Bonnie Leonard. "As a team they were a joy to watch, and I'm very proud of my boy." - Mary Ann Ralston
