Pet First Aid By Dr. Beth Engelbert, DVM

Special thank you to Beth for presenting the topic on Pet First Aid. The information was very helpful, and for those that were not able to attend, we will include parts of Beth's presentation in future newsletters.

First Aid Kit Essentials

Muzzle (can use Ace Bandage)	Bandage Scissors	Surgical Scrub
Extra Leash	Latex Gloves	Thermometer (cheap digital + petroleum jelly)
Gauze	Tweezers	Toenail Trimmer

Non-Stick Tefla Pads	“Hemostats” (clamp like scissors)	Saline Solution eyewash
Vet Wrap or Ace Bandages	Kwik Stop Powder	Container to store everything (tackle box or Tupperware)
Medical or Duct Tape	Hydrogen Peroxide	
The following items should be obtained from your Vet for your kit		
Antibiotic Ointment	Triple Antibiotic Eye Ointment	Extra Medication your pet is on
Benadryl tablets – check with vet on dosage	Vet’s contact information

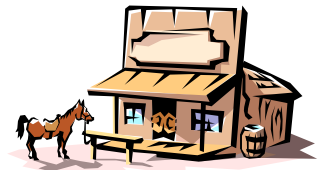
