- Have obedience and rally before agility because the time per run can be more accurately estimated. Perhaps set a time for agility to start based on anticipated number of entries, and limit entries to that number
- In order to qualify for a free run, volunteers must pre-register
- If jumpers is done outside, there needs to be someone to take responsibility for supervising the runs as well as setting up the course
- We should go back to a system of identifying who has paid for which runs by using tickets or hand stamps
- Consider not having any food for sale
- If food is sold, keep food and run money separate

The question was raised as to whether the purpose of matches is to raise money or to provide training experience for members. The consensus was that both are purposes. Since there are so few fun matches in the area, the club should continue to hold matches.
